



Cooperation Agreement

Which was created between the International Council for Game and Wildlife Conservation / (hereafter CIC), and the International Association of Hunting Journalists / (hereinafter referred to as IAHJ) on the conservation and sustainable use of wildlife, as well as on the development of international communication on hunting and conservation – in Budapest, on February 14, 2013.

1./ As the legal successor of the European Association of Hunting Journalists founded in 2007, registered in Switzerland, the International Association of Hunting Journalists announces the introduction of "first-hand" information practices.

- In this context, the IAHJ undertakes that it will receive – first hand – from the CIC information, news, reports, photos, videos, etc. and display these immediately on its online information magazine created in four languages: www.huntingpress.eu, in the languages provided by the CIC.
- agrees to edit the material, which the CIC then transmits to editors and journalists who are part of this association.
- furthermore, provides space for the important information submitted by the CIC within the IAHJ newsletter.

2./ The CIC – through its Headquarters – as part of this cooperation agrees to send "first hand" information in English, German and French: news, information, photos, videos, etc. to the IAHJ head office in Budapest, in order to include these on the World Wide Web as soon as possible.

3./ The CIC activities, particularly with regard to the international communication network on hunting, supports the activities of EVS and offers inter alia international meeting possibilities for IAHJ in the framework of the CIC General Assemblies.

4./ The Parties declare that they respect each other's interests, and do not expect financial contribution from the partners for common communication activities.
